## MCSA Competition By-Laws

MCSA adopts LOTG with some by-laws as follows:

1. Two 40-minute halves with a 5 minute break. There is no extra time.
2. The substitution rule applies to Premier League. The interchange rule applies to all other leagues. In all cases, a maximum of six players is allowed on the bench.
3. MVP votes (3, 2 & 1) are required on the team sheet for every game.
4. Match results (team sheets) must be submitted by 7pm the same day. \*\*
5. Compression wear can be either Black or White or colour that matches with the jersey.
6. Minimum of 7 players (per team) to start a game.
7. Strictly no smoking or alcohol on the sports field. Strictly no smoking or alcohol within a school complex. This is a reportable offense.
8. Each team must provide a Mitre match ball at the start of the game. This is a reportable offense.
9. A player is permitted to wear a different shirt number than the one on the team sheet. This (change) must be communicated with the match officials before the game and the replacement number clearly noted on the team sheet alongside the player. Number sharing in the same game is not permitted.
10. When conducting uniform check, ensure that all the players must have the MCSA badge on their shirts. This is a reportable offense.

For all the reportable offenses above, simply note on the relevant team sheet if possible or email as a report.
